Specific regulations

1. Organisation

Postnord UCI Women's WorldTour Vårgårda WestSweden is organised by Vårgårda Cykelklubb, Box 55, S-447 22 Vårgårda under regulations of the International Cycling Union (UCI) on Sunday August 18, 2019

2. Type of event

The event is open for riders of the Women Elite and U23 categories. The event is entered on the UCI Calendar as a UCI Women's WorldTour event.

Points are awarded towards the UCI Road Women WorldTour classification (as per article 2.13.006)

3. Participation

As per article 2.13.005 the UCI Women's WorldTour events is open to UCI Women's WorldTeams and UCI women's continental teams. In accordance with article 2.1.005 the race is open for a national team from the country of the organizer and maximum one foreign national team. The maximum number of teams at the start of a UCI Women's WorldTour event is set at 24 teams.

Teams shall be formed of six riders in accordance with article 2.2.003

4. Race Headquarters

Race Headquarters are located at **Kyrkogatan 7, Vårgårda**. Approximately 200 meters after the start/finish

5. Radio tour

Race information will be given over Radio Tour on frequency 146,4125 MHz.

6. Neutral technical support

The neutral support is handled by the organiser with 3 cars.

7. Finishing time limits

Any rider finishing in a time exceeding that of the winner by more than 8% shall not be placed. The time limit may, in exceptional circumstances, be increased by the Commissaries Panel in agreement with the organizer.

8. Classifications

The following classifications will be issued:

- Individual classification by time.
- Individual secondary classification young riders, U23.

Prize money will be sent directly to team bank account.

Team representatives will be asked to submit full account details with international IBAN-code to which payment should be done at the Race Headquarters.





10. Antidoping

The UCI antidoping regulations are entirely applicable to the event.

Test will take place at Vårgårda Health Centre, Centrumgatan 2, approximately 400 meters from Start- and Finish area.

11. Awards ceremony

In accordance with article 2.14.008 of the UCI rules, the following riders must attend the official awards ceremony:

- -The first 3 riders of the event.
- -The individual leader of the UCI Road Women World Cup after the event.
- -The leader of the best young riders classification

The riders have to be present at the podium not later than 10 minutes after finishing at Murartorget.

After the award ceremony, the winner of the event and the leader of the UCI Women's WorldTour after the event are required to attend the press conference in the company of the organiser.

3. Driving your car

Security remains the single most important factor for our organisation in all our events. Therefore we urge you all to pay the highest attention and drive carefully both during race and at any other time.

During race it is of course absolutely prohibited to drive in the non-race direction or to deviate from the course if not instructed to do so by police or security staff. Dipped headlights should be switched on during driving. Always use the seat belts.

The organisation applies a zero limit rule for alcohol during driving. Tests might be carried out.

4. **Environment**

We all love cycling on all levels and to be able to enjoy it we need a clean and beautiful nature.

The organisation of Postnord UCI WWT Vårgårda WestSweden continues to work in different fora and with different local and regional councils to promote cycling in all its different forms; as the best means of local transport, as recreation for all as well as environmental friendly and the best way to experience the beautiful Swedish nature.

During the World Tour weekend we count on your support;

- Please do not litter anything during the race, for bottles or other items we ask you to use our GARBAGE ZONES immediately after the feeding zones.

Race information

1. Course

The course is described in the enclosed road maps, profiles and calculated passing times. The race starts with 1 lap á 66,7 km, followed by 3 short Hägrungalaps á 11,0 km and continues with 3 long Hägrungalaps á 15,2 km. Total course 145,3 km. The first long lap contains 5 gravel sections, marked as 1,2,3,4 and 5. Gravel section 5 is also included in the long Hägrungalap.

2. Team presentation

All teams will be presented to the public, in order given at latest atTeam Managers Meeting, at the podium on Murartorget, Vårgårda (in the start-area). The presentation starts at Sunday 18/8, 09.45

3. Start

Start at 11.00

4. Equipment

All riders have to wear electronic device (chip) to be automatically registered for finish. Information will be given on the team managers meeting and at the registration.

5. Radio communication

All vehicles following the race must be equipped with working radio communication (Radio Tour) . Radios are distributed at the team managers ´ meeting.

After the race, radios must be returned to Race Headquarters, otherwise the team will be charged a cost of SEK 5000/ Euro 545.

Radio Tour will operate on frequency 146,4125 MHz.

The race will also be broadcasted over the local radio network, 97,0 MHz (in Swedish only).

6. Feeding


Feeding is allowed within the feeding zones and from car according to UCI-regulations. Information will be given at the team managers meeting.


Course, long lap 66,7 km








Course, short lap Hägrunga 11 km

Profile long lap Hägrunga, 15,4 km




Profile, last 3 km
